Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures

Before-School Morning Care – Before-School care will be located in the gym. Parents who wish for their student to participate in the before-school care must walk their student into the gym from 7:15 – 7:55 a.m. Students

must be signed-in by an adult.

Regular Drop-off – Doors will open at 7:55 for students and will remain open until 8:30. Drop-off will begin at 7:55 a.m. in front of the building. The lane furthest from the building will be used for drop-off. School personnel will be on duty to assist and monitor students, as well as the traffic.

Car Rider Dismissal

Pick-up will begin at 3:30 p.m. in front of the building. Both lanes will be utilized for the purpose of expedience. Cones will be placed near the cafeteria to indicate where the first cars in each row will begin the pick-up process. Students' names will be called and when the students are in the vehicles, a school staff member will release the cars one at a time.

We kindly ask that parents be attentive when dropping-off and picking-up students, avoiding distractions which may draw your attention away from the movement of students, adults, and other traffic. Our goal is to keep everyone safe!
