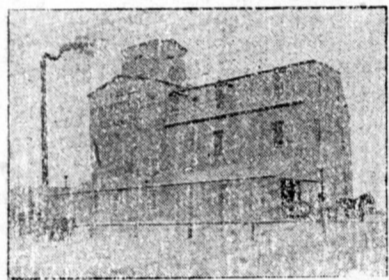

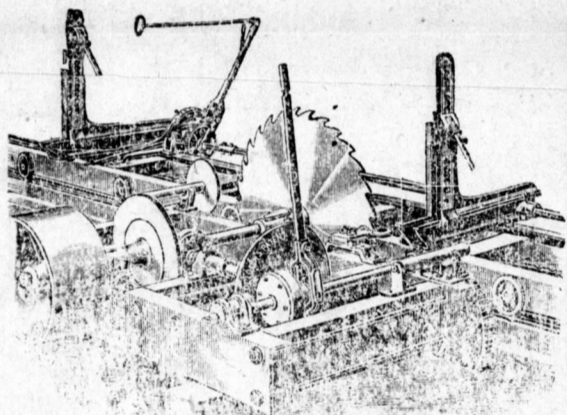

### A Strange Accident.

A remarkable story comes from Brainerd, says the Bemidji Pioneer. It will be remembered that Edward Berg was shot in the head by a companion while hunting near Mary last January. He was taken to the hospital at Brainerd more dead than alive and was discharged from there about three weeks ago, apparently cured. Then Berg made a discovery which startled the medical world. Before the accident he could talk English fluently. He now cannot remember a single English word, although his own language, Norwegian, stays with him. He is learning the forgotten language over again, word by word. And this is a difficult task. The operation was a difficult one, the recovery remarkable and the result is one of the strangest on record. It sounds fishy, but the truth is fully verified. As the result of being shot, Berg lost perhaps two drachms of brain tissue and the skin of his forehead is all that keeps the brain in place. It seems strange that the part of the brain removed should contain all of his knowledge of English.

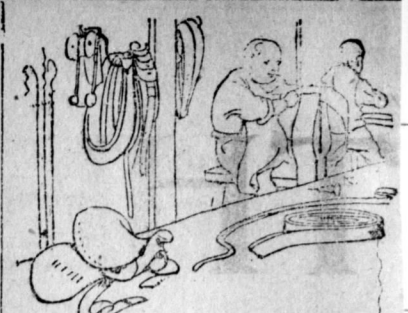
