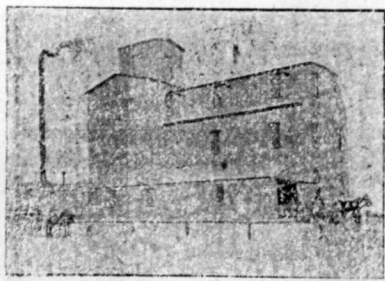

Ringstad president, A. J. Olson vice president and C. Olson secretary, O. M. Olson treasurer and W. L. Hilliard captain of the uniform company.

The Indian department is considering a new scheme for the education of the Indians. It is to give each Indian boy a plot of ground, allow him to cultivate it and give him the proceeds arising from the sale of the articles grown. It is said that this scheme was tried in Colorado last year, and the results were so good that the effort will be made to introduce it wherever it is practical. On some reservations it is impossible to give each student a specific amount of ground, because the school farms are too small. However, it is said there is plenty of land belonging to the Indians in Minnesota, Wisconsin and the Dakotas, and it is not unlikely that the experiment will be tried in the northwest. Advantage of such training, it is claimed, will develop a spirit of thrift in the Indian and go a long way toward making him a self supporting member of society.
