The 32nd annual Kansas State Demolition Derby adds another long-standing event tradition to Hoisington's Labor Day activities and another chance to spend the day in the sun.

The Sunday event at Bicentennial Park begins with inspections at 8 a.m. for participants and 12:30 p.m. driver's meeting. Heat competitions begin at 1.

Derby drivers will be vying for nearly \$3,000 in prize money and trophies. The event is hosted by the Hoisington Chamber of Commerce, with sponsor support from Superior Essex, JRZ Enterprises, and

Hoisington's Labor Day organizers have learned over the years that no four-day event would be complete without some sports.

With the good fortune of the 2015 prep football season falling on the evening of the first day, the Hoisington Cardinals' seasonopener with Larned was incorporated into the Labor Day schedule. Expecting a large number of alumni back for the weekend, those who will be attending reunions will be granted free admission to the high school game Parr Sound and Lighting. The Chamber notes that Chad Markley/ Markley Demolition, Inc. will be providing the officiating, inspecting, and announcing of the action this year. Rules and regulations will be followed as outlined by MDI (Markley Demolition, Inc.).

The Derby will again have three classes of competition, with the return of the boltand-chain class from last year's event. First place in the Old-Iron/ Modified Class will receive \$1,250; second place \$700; third place \$400, fourth place \$250 and fifth place \$150. Compact prizes are: first place, \$600; second place, \$300; third place, \$200; and

fourth place, \$100. Bolt-and-chain prizes are: first place, \$800; second place, \$400; and third place, \$200.

All placing cars will receive a trophy. Prizes of \$30 each will be presented to the three finalists in each heat.

The Hoisington Derby is a member of the Kansas Championship Demolition Derby Association. As per regulations, drivers must be 18 years of age. Cars must be American models only, with no trucks, convertibles or Chrysler Imperials. Crash helmets and seatbelts are required.

Gate tickets are \$10 for adults, \$5 for children 4-12 and children 3 and under are free. Pit passes are \$15.




A fifth-quarter beer garden at 7th and Main in Hoisington follows the game for adults who want to talk over the action.
