we're tired."

The Bombers are hoping to make big strides offensively after an up and down 2015. The team will benefit from three returning starters on the offensive line, several key skill players and a new offensive coordinator in Aaron Thomas.

"The biggest point is our offensive line needs to get it going," Hall said. "They've looked the best at this point since I've been here."

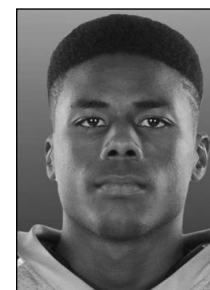
Hall is also looking for major upgrades on special teams. The Bombers gave up two return touchdowns against Booker T.

Washington last year and regularly struggled with their coverage units.

The Bombers non-district schedule includes a couple of east side contenders in Muskogee and Booker T. Washington along with rival Del City.

Midwest City opens district play against Lawton on Sept. 23. The Wolverines claimed the last two district titles following late-season wins over Midwest City. The two schools should be the favorites in District 6A-II-1.

Other contenders include; Deer Creek, Choctaw, Stillwater, Putnam City, Putnam City West and Enid. Putnam City West has several Division I recruits and Putnam City could be a
