DIVISION IX - FLORICULTURE Rules:

- 1. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO REPLACE ALL DEAD FLOWERS WITH FRESH ONES DURING FAIR WEEK. All dead flowers will be discarded.
- 2. Entries will be judged 1/3 on flowers; **POTTED PLANTS:** 1/3 on arrangement; & 1/3 on container, Lot 1 Boston Fern – foliage not to except specimens.
- 3. All specimens will be displayed Lot 2 Fern Any Other Variety in bottles provided by floriculture Lot 3 Begonia department at entry, and will be Lot 4 Geranium judged on flower only – container not Lot 5 Sultana considered.
- 4. No plants or arrangements will be Lot 7 African Violet, single accepted in Class I and II if the container Lot 8 African Violet, double is more than 12" in diameter.
- 5. No artificial flowers will be accepted. 6. Not responsible for containers that are Lot 11 Any Other lost or broken.
- 7. Every effort will be made to preserve **POTTED SUCCULENTS** the condition of all plants, but the Fair Lot 12 Cactus – not to exceed 15" will not be responsible for changes due to temperature, lighting and watering conditions.

8. Potted plants must have been in Lot 16 Sedum exhibitor's possession three months. Total height must not exceed 24".

9. No DRIED flowers. 10. All Containers must have a saucer to catch water.
