2 Mile and 5 K Run, and Ranch Rodeo. Fair books for the Pawnee County Fair are available to exhibitors at www.pawneecountyfair.com or the Pawnee County Extension Office. These books provide detailed entry and class information. Some classes require pre-entry. All items may

be entered on Wednesday, July 27, from 11:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. If you don't plan to exhibit, at least take part in the special events that are planned. In addition to those listed above there will be a Chamber Coffee Hour, Food Sale, Team Roping (Thursday), Pedal Tractor Pull, Watermelon Feed,

Ranch Rodeo (Friday), Frog & Turtle Race, Inflate - O - Fun Water Slip & Slide, and Pig Wrestling (Saturday) with many booths to be enjoyed by all. These activities are planned with the idea to get the whole community involved. The Pawnee County Fair Association hopes there

is something that would interest everyone. Also included in our fair schedule, is a list of when judging of the different classes occurs. The judging of livestock is a public show and people are encouraged to come and watch the shows that interest them. While you're on the fairgrounds, plan to browse
