Center for Counseling and Consultation serves community

The Center for Counseling and Consultation has been serving the mental health needs of Central Kansas for nearly fifty years.

The agency was founded under Kansas law in 1967 by joint resolution of the county commissioners of Barton, Rice and Stafford Counties in conjunction with the local mental health association with the goal of being a community resource "where people with psycho-social problems" could receive help and guidance. In 1975, Pawnee County joined The Center's catchment area when Larned State Hospital closed its outpatient services program. Initially called "Mid-Kansas Mental Health Center," it opened to the public on January 16, 1968, with a staff of only three – a reception, a psychologist and a social worker. A brochure from its opening indicated that "in addition to treatment, it provided education, prevention, consultation and research in the mental health field."

While the primary goal of being a community resource has not change, The Center's programs have expanded over time to now include medication evaluations, case management and addiction recovery services. Today, the staff has grown to approximately ninety and includes the area's only fulltime outpatient psychiatrist. Its primary location is in Great Bend on Broadway Ave. west of Patton Road and has satellite offices in Larned, Lyons and Stafford.

The Center receives both State and local public funds and is governed by a Board made of appointees from each of the representative counties. As a state licensed community mental health center, they serve as a safety net for those in mental crisis. The Center accepts most major insurances and offer an income based sliding fee schedule.
