

Goldthwaite Municipal Airport Welcomes Fliers



Now you can access Goldthwaite by air. With the completion of the Goldthwaite Airport, designated T37, those wishing to fly into Goldthwaite can land on the 3,200 foot runway. The airport is conveniently located 2.6 miles south of Goldthwaite on State Highway 16 South, next to the Goldthwaite Golf Course. It is open for daylight operations. A terminal building is available to pilots, and includes: office space, wifi and computer terminals, a meeting room,

and bathrooms. The building is also available for rental for meetings, organizations, weddings, family reunions and fundraisers. The Golf Association headquarters has relocated to the terminal building, and you can fly in and play golf. Construction of hangars is complete and some spaces may be available for rent.
