The Dive-In movie series started July 1 and continues with "Zootopia" on July 14, "Captain America's Civil War" on July 21 and "Finding Dory" on July 28.

"Dive-In Movies at White Water Bay will take place each Friday night in July," Baier said. "Guests are invited to pull up a tube or lounge chair and enjoy a family-friendly flick at the 500,000-gallon Monsoon Bay Wave Pool. All Dive-In Movies are free with park admission."

White Water will be open late on Wednesdays until 9 p.m. June 7 through Aug. 9.

Baier said White Water Bay has added two new thrill slides in addition to its Acapulco Cliff Dive, Bermuda Triangle and CannonBall Falls attractions.

Baier said the water park attracts about 275,000 visitors a year.

"We are hoping for more than that," she said. "It depends on how the weather fares. When the
