Turning the Chickasha night sky into a glowing spectacular, the annual City of Chickasha Festival of Light has returned for its 25th anniversary.

The Festival of Light, located in the Shannon Springs Park, opened Saturday, Nov. 18, and remains open until Dec. 31. Hours of operation are 6

to 10 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and 6 to 11 p.m. on Friday and Saturday.

This year's Festival of Light will include a live nativity scene, camel rides, carriage rides, laser tag, petting zoo and a course of more than three million twinkling lights.

New attractions for this year's anniversary include an animated display, a ferris wheel, additional

parking and several food trucks. Attendees can also get their picture taken with Santa in the Christmas Village area.

Over 250,000 visitors come from all over the world to visit the Festival of Light, which has earned many awards from the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and other organizations.
