Last month, Alexander Central sophomore distance runner Cooper Castellaw competed in a highly-competitive race at the David Oliver Classic event held at the JDL Fast Track in Winston-Salem.

One of the state's top sophomore distance runners, Castellaw posted a 16th place finish in the 3,200-meter race held January 28, at JDL. Castellaw posted a time of 9:57.23 in the event. According to ACHS Track & Field Coach Jonathan Winkler, Castellaw's time in the event is a new school record for a two-mile race.

Notary Public class is required for individuals seeking to obtain their NC Commission as a Notary Public. Each class is taught by a certified instructor and provides a thorough introduction to the statutes which regulate the acts of North Carolina notaries. The purpose of the education requirement is to enable the applicant to become a responsible, qualified candidate for Notary Public commission.

The second class will be held on Saturday, Feb. 25, from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., on CVCC East Campus, Room 1001. Registration cut off is Jan. 31. Guidebook must be read prior to attending class. The third class will be held on Tuesday, Feb. 28, from 8:30 a.m., until 4:30 p.m., at the CVCC Alexander Center for Education in Taylorsville. Registration cut off is Jan. 31. Guidebook must be read prior to attending class. The cost for each class is \$75.
