**PAYMENT OF FEES**

**ELEMENTARY STUDENT FEES**

Student fee structure: K-5, \$35; fifth grade band, \$6; grades 3-5 technology fee, \$15.

Each student will need gym shoes to keep at school and a shirt that can be used for art class.

**SCHOOL LUNCH AND BREAKFAST PROGRAM**

School lunch prices for grades 6-12 will be \$2.75, adult lunch, \$3. Students in grades K-5 will pay \$2.50. Breakfast is \$1.75. Milk is 50¢. Free and reduced lunch applications will be distributed during the first week of school.

Breakfast is served each day from 7:45-8:15 a.m.

Free and reduced meal applications will be available Tuesday, Aug. 15 during the open house, from the website, careyevs.schoolwires.com or during the first week of school.

**EARLY DISMISSAL AND CALAMITY DAYS**

The school realizes that

there are homes which must make special arrangements due to the cancellation or early dismissal of school. The school asks that you make arrangements if this occurs. In either of these events, the school will activate the automated calling system and notify the following radio and TV stations: WFIN 1330 AM, WKXA 100.5 FM, WBVI 96.7 FM, WPFX 107.7 FM, all in Findlay; WFOB 1430 AM, Fostoria and WYNT 95.9 FM Upper Sandusky; WTOL, WNWO and ABC.

**BUS INFORMATION**

Parents of kindergarten children will be notified of their bus number, time and location of pick up and drop off by their child's bus driver before the first day of school. If any changes have been made to your child's bus route, you will be notified before the first day of school.

With so many working parents and special transportation requests each year, some guidelines have been established:

- The school must remain on a time schedule. Too many additional stops can create problems with time schedules and the number of students per bus.

- The school cannot adjust the routes for babysitter requests. The school can honor a bus stop on an established route, but is not able to adjust a route to fit parents' work schedules. If a babysitter does not live on an established route, then it will be the parents' or babysitter's responsibility to bring the child to the nearest bus stop for pick-up in the morning and delivery after school.

**ATTENDANCE PROCEDURE**

In April 1985, the Ohio Legislature passed a law which requires school districts to notify parents when their child is absent. To assist the school with this regulation, parents or guardians are requested to notify the school by 9 a.m. on the day their child is absent. Phone the school at 419-396-7922 and choose option 1.

**PRE-PLANNED ABSENCE FORM**

Students are required to submit a pre-planned absence form to the office for any days they wish to have excused for family vacations or time they will be showing/working at the county fair. The form will be available in the high school office, elementary office and online at careyevs.schoolwires.com. The pre-planned absence form must be completed and submitted for approval at least two days in advance of the absence.
