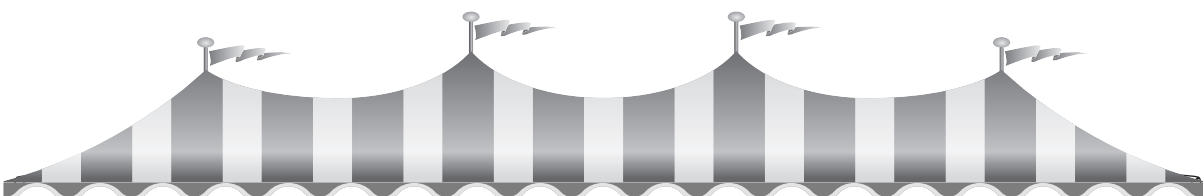

Blood Tests

9/12 – 9/16 from 9:30 – 11 am • Results will be mailed to participants

- \$30** automated CBC, full lipid profile, basic metabolic panel & AST/ALT
✓ blood test includes hemoglobin, white cell count, total cholesterol, HDL, LDL, triglycerides & ratio, glucose (blood sugar), electrolytes, kidney function & liver enzymes
✓ for the most accurate results, please fast 12 hours prior to the test
- \$20** TSH & Free T4 - Blood test for thyroid function – no fasting needed
- \$15** A1C - Test for average blood glucose control for the past 2-3 months with no fasting needed
- \$10** PSA - Blood test for prostate-specific antigen – no fasting needed

• WMH offers the community health screenings as a special outreach project • No physician orders for additional testing will be accepted at the screenings, and no insurance plans will be billed

Blood Pressure & Oxygen Saturation Checks

9/12, 9/13 & 9/14 from 9:30 am – 6 pm • 9/15 & 9/16 from 9:30 am – 2 pm

- Free screenings to
 - determine risk of hypertension, an indicator for heart disease and stroke
 - measure the percentage of red blood cells carrying oxygen to vital organs & tissues
