

THINGS TO KNOW FOR THE 2017 FAIR

Important info for Junior Fair participants

The Junior Fair is composed of the Wyandot County 4-H clubs, FFA chapters, FCCLA chapters, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, school art and industrial art departments. Entries are open to any girl or boy officially enrolled and in good standing in one or more of these groups in Wyandot County during the current year.

Any FFA student residing in Wyandot County is eligible to exhibit at the Wyandot County Fair if approved by a vo-ag teacher. Students from Carey, Mohawk and Upper Sandusky schools who are attending a joint vocational school are eligible to exhibit if they meet all other requirements found in the 2017 Wyandot County Fair premium book. Junior Fair participants can not have passed their 19th birthday by Jan. 1 of the current year.

EXHIBITORS CAN CHECK IN ON SUNDAY

All exhibitors, except rabbits, can bring their animals in to the fairgrounds starting Sunday, Sept. 10, starting at noon until Monday, Sept. 11, at 9 p.m. Rabbits can only check in on Monday, Sept. 11, from 4-9 p.m. No weigh in and check in until 4 p.m. on Monday, Sept. 11.

Exhibitors are responsible for the feeding and security of the animals and must abide by stall assignments made by department advisors. Exhibitors are responsible for checking in and weighing in the animal on Monday, Sept. 11 from 4-9 p.m.

JUNIOR FAIR DRESS CODE

The requirements for all shows and sales are as follows: Pants/jeans with no holes. Full button-up shirts, no polos, to be buttoned from bottom to at least two buttons from the collar and tucked in for all shows/sale. Exhibitor will not be permitted to enter the ring without wearing

appropriate attire. Judges will be informed of this dress code. Please check dairy and horses for their additional requirements.

EXHIBITOR PASSES

Each exhibitor must have an exhibitor pass. The cost is \$5 for Junior Fair exhibitors and \$25 for advisors; youth exhibiting in Senior Fair Open Class will be required to purchase a youth season pass for \$10.

Exhibitors would pay either the Junior Fair price of \$5 or the season pass price for \$10. Even though participants may belong to one or more organization, they will only have one pass. The decision to exhibit in Junior Fair or Junior and Open Class should be made at the time of purchasing a pass, which can be done in the Senior Fair office.

Exhibitor passes that have

already been purchased will be available for pickup at the Junior Fair arena office Saturday, Sept. 9, from 9 a.m.-5 p.m., Sunday, Sept. 10, from 10 a.m.-5 p.m. and Monday, Sept. 11 from 2-8 p.m.

PREMIUM CHECKS

Premium checks will be available Sunday, Sept. 17, at the Junior Fair office from 3-8 p.m. to all Junior Fair exhibitors who made an entry and exhibited project(s) during the fair. Premium checks will be available after the fair at the Senior Fair office on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, from 9:30 a.m.- 3 p.m. until Oct. 31. One premium check will be issued to each Junior Fair exhibitor regardless of how many Junior Fair organizations they belong to. An itemized listing appears below the check stub indicating the amount paid for each project. All non deposited

checks will be void after Nov. 1, 2017.

JUNIOR FAIR SHOWMANSHIP

Each livestock exhibitor is encouraged to enter the showmanship classes. There is no entry form but be sure to check the bulletin board in the departments to see if a sign-up is required.

Exhibitors must use their project animals which they have shown or will show in other classes in Junior Fair.

An exhibitor's age on Jan. 1 of the current year determines the showmanship division he/she participates in.
