



## G-Star Students Work With Stars and Celebrities

PALM SPRINGS - NFL Hall of Famer Joe Namath, golfers Michelle Wie and Rory McIlroy, and one of baseball's highest paid players, Bryce Harper, all recently appeared in major commercials at G-Star Studios owned by the G-Star School of the Arts for Film, Animation and Performing Arts.

**VILLAGE OF PALM SPRINGS WATER UTILITIES Department Will Flush Lines with Free Chlorine Starting June 5, 2017 through June 23, 2017**

To maintain high water quality in the Village's water distribution system, the Village of Palm Springs Water Utilities Department will temporarily modify the disinfection process used to treat our drinking water.

Starting June 5, 2017 through June 23, 2017 a "free chlorine residual" water treatment method will be used to provide a stronger disinfection process in place of regular "combined chlorine and chloramines" which are normally used. As part of this process, the city will be flushing fire hydrants throughout the Village. Please note that this is a preventative maintenance process.

Customers served by the Village of Palm Springs Water Utilities Department may notice a slight chlorine taste or odor in their tap water during this period. These temporary conditions will not cause adverse health effects. If you are especially sensitive to the taste or odor of chlorine, keep an open container of drinking water in your refrigerator for a few hours to allow the chlorine to dissipate.

Users of home dialysis machines, owners of tropical fish and managers of stores and restaurants with fish and shellfish holding tanks are advised to seek professional advice as the method for removing chlorine residuals differs from removing chloramines residuals from tap water.

**A little Ice please!** Summer time is right around the corner. We know this by looking at our calendars...otherwise with the temperatures the way they are, it's already telling us that summer is here. Well, the way we are getting some extra growing time in for our green lettuces in the hydroponics is to "fake em' out". First we put some shade cloth over the system to block out some of the sun. The shade cloth also keeps leaves from falling into the system too. The other thing we are just now starting to do again for this year is to put jugs of ice into the water reservoir. The reason for closed jugs is so the nutrient mix doesn't get off balanced. If we just put in ice, it melts and would dilute the water/nutrient mix.

We make sure we stay on top of the correct PH level too. The PH level helps the plants to uptake the nutrients. We want to make sure the plants are as healthy as they can be. They're already facing the heat!

**Here's a tid bit about mulch...** the code for the city of Lake Worth:

"Organic mulches. However, organic mulches shall not, by themselves, constitute landscaping. No more than



twenty-five (25) percent of a front or side street setback or yard may be comprised of mulch independent of living plant materials. All planting areas shall incorporate the use of organic mulch and it shall be applied to a minimum depth of three (3) inches. A layer of organic mulch shall be required in plant beds and around individual trees in turf grass areas. The use of cypress mulch is discouraged. Why do I bring this up? Because the plants need protection from the heat. A good layer of mulch holds the moisture AND we have lots of FREE mulch at the garden. You just need to pick it up!
