National Park Week, held lum estate of John McMurran, April 15 through 23 this year, is a week in April annually proclaimed for the celebration and recognition of our national parks. Celebrations will be marked with special events and activities including National Junior Ranger Day on April 15 and Earth Day on April 22. Our national parks are living examples of the best this Nation has to offer-our magnificent natural landscapes and our varied yet interrelated heritage. Parks can provide outdoor opportunities, recreational experiences and places of quiet retreat.

"Our National Parks are our national treasure," said Secretary of the Interior Ryan Zinke. "My formative years were spent in Glacier National Park and one of my biggest mentors was a park ranger and football coach. The lessons you learn from the land and the park rangers cannot be learned anywhere else on earth. As we head into the next 100 years of the Park Service, I'm looking at ways to improve infrastructure and visitor experience while conserving the precious lands for generations to come."

Of the 417 national parks, there are eight in Mississippi. Some include:

Brices Cross Roads National Battlefield Site is where Major General Nathan Bedford Forrest obtained a significant Confederate victory in 1864. However, its long-term effect on the war proved costly. This site is a perfect example of winning the battle, but losing the war.

Tupelo National Battlefield is where the battle of Tupelo was fought by more than 20,000 troops. Major General William Sherman successfully kept Major General Nathan Bedford Forrest away from the Federal supply line in Tennessee in June of 1864.

The Vicksburg National Military Park/Cemetery commemorates the campaign, siege and defense of Vicksburg. Its sur-


