The City of Durant, through its Code Enforcement Officer, shall notify by first class mail the owner and/or occupant that a par-

cel that is in violation of this ordinance. If the Code Enforcement Officer cannot notify the owner or occupant of the parcel, then notice may be posted in a conspicuous place on a building or structure on the parcel. The owner or occupant shall be given five days in which to correct the violation.
