This ordinance applies to residential, business and industrial parcels, whether occupied or not, provided that such parcels have a building or structure intended for the shelter, housing, or enclosure of persons, animals, or property.

Article III  
Grass in excess of six inches shall be deemed a nuisance per SE on such parcels. This Ordinance does not apply to ornamental grass.

Article IV  
It shall be the duty of all owners and occupants of parcels having a building intended for the shelter, housing, or enclosure of persons, animals, or property to cut and maintain any grass on said parcel to a height less than six inches.

Article V  
It shall be the duty of all owners and occupants when the lawn is cut and maintained to ensure that the clippings and debris blown during mowing into the street, gutter and/or ditches is removed so as to not clog or impair the City's drainage system.

Article VI  
The City of Durant, through its Code Enforcement Officer, shall notify by first class mail the owner and/or occupant that a par-
