Chamber to hold political forum for Clinton's 2017 municipal election

The Clinton Chamber of Commerce will be hosting a political forum to hear from the candidates in the upcoming municipal elections on Thursday, April 20, from 7 until 9 p.m. at South Point Business Park. The event is open to the public and is free. The moderator, Gerad Hardy, will ask the candidates a series of questions, in addition to all participating political candidates being introduced and given three minutes for brief remarks about themselves.

social media page on the night of the event, pending no impediments," said Hardy.

"We believe that the format for the political forum, as well as the questions we have submitted for the candidates, should allow citizens to be more informed. The format allows for our candidates to be asked three questions that all will answer, and two randomly selected questions for each candidate selected from community submitted questions."
