Senior offensive and defensive lineman Jay Thornton, at 5'11', 275 pounds, anchors a young offensive line.

Senior defensive lineman Devin Trunell, at 6'4" and 265 pounds is expected to lead the defensive front, but recently suffered a hamstring injury and is hoping to be back to full speed by the season opener.

Senior kicker Tanner May is considered one of the best kickers in the league and has been accurate on field goals from the 40-45 yard range.

Senior tight end, linebacker Brandon Buchanan is also expected to be an impact player and a great team leader.

Another senior leader is linebacker, tight end and wide receiver Seth May, at 5'11" and 185 pounds.

"Our senior class is small, but talented, with a lot of great team leaders. We are depending on those guys to lead us this year."
