Tenth-grader Makiya Hunter and eleventh grader Kenzie Lawrence provided the power in the middle of the order by combining for six home runs and six triples. The majority of the team's pitching was handled by ninth-grader Hanna



Zeitz. She went twenty-three and five over 149 innings with 179 strikeouts and fourteen earned runs allowed.

The coaches say that the success of these young players and the sting of not winning the State Championship will only motivate these young ladies to come back next year stronger than ever.
