Goodwill Industries of Mississippi opened its seventh retail store in the Clinton East Shopping Center, located at 941 Highway 80 in Clinton, during Grand Opening ceremonies from November 9-11.

The new 15,200 square foot location is a full-service store – accepting donations, offering a large shopping floor space and housing the Operation Center for e-commerce sales.

“The Clinton store opening means fifteen new jobs have been created for

persons with disabilities or with barriers to employment,” says Goodwill of Mississippi CEO David Hollingsworth. “It is the heart of our Goodwill mission and the strategic expansion of our well-known brand. We are delighted to be joining the Clinton community and have already met with City officials, business leaders and residents.”

“It is a pleasure to welcome Goodwill to the city of Clinton and the Highway 80 business district,” said Clinton Mayor Phil Fisher. “Goodwill and the City have worked closely to locate a facility that will benefit our residents and allow

Like other stores in central Mississippi, store hours at the Clinton Select Store will be Monday through Saturday, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Donations may be made at the store during business hours by dropping off clothing, housewares, appliances and electronics in working order, furniture,



books and DVDS/CDs. Goodwill of Mississippi is a not-for-profit organization with a mission of assisting people with disabilities and other barriers to obtain employment. The organization was founded in Jackson, Mississippi in 1957. Funding is primarily driven through recycling of community donations, which are sold at Goodwill retail outlets – and that process creates jobs. Eighty-three cents of every dollar goes directly towards training, career services and employment.
