Here is an example of what the Kizer Pharmacy team excels at doing on a daily basis.

A patient brought in the following prescriptions hoping we could help them save money and keep them from "having to use" an out of town pharmacy due to insurance.

Januvia 50mg #90 (A brand only diabetic drug). Copay at out of town, "preferred pharmacy" was \$120 where it was \$135 at Kizer Pharmacy. Also, the patient was taking Vytorin for the same \$120, which at the time, was a brand only cholesterol combination of Simvastatin and Zetia. In a nutshell, the member was driving out of town every 3 months to save \$30 on a total copay of \$240. After we consulted with the patient and the prescriber, the member was changed from Januvia to a drug in the same class that had a generic. This dropped the copay from \$120 to \$30. The Vytorin was broken up into 2 separate prescription of Simvastatin and generic Zetia for a total copay of \$9 and \$30, respectively.

Patient Drug Regimen before coming to Kizer Pharmacy:

Januvia 50 mg #90 : \$120 Copay
Vytorin 20/10mg #90: \$120 Copay

Total: \$240

After coming to Kizer Pharmacy and prescriber/pharmacist solution:

Alogliptin 12.5 mg #90: \$30 Copay
Simvastatin 20 mg #90: \$9 Copay
Generic Zetia 10 mg #90: \$30 Copay

Total: \$69

To top it off, as we counseled this patient on the new medications, we noticed he was purchasing Aleve. He mentioned that it was for his arthritic joints that had worsened over the last several months. As it turns out, he had not informed his physician about it. We suspected that perhaps the cholesterol medicine might be contributing to his joint pain and that he inform his physician. After he visited his physician, the cholesterol medicines were discontinued and after a few weeks the patient's symptoms were much improved.
