der CFR 24 Part 58 has conducted an evaluation as required by Executive Order 11988 and/or 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management, to determine the potential affect that its activity in the floodplain and/or wetland will have on the human environment for a Community Development Block Grant HUD Grant Number B-17-DC-47-0001. The City of Martin's Sewer System improvement project which will consist of addressing inflow and infiltration (I/I) problems that plague the existing wastewater collection system and repair a failed 18" aerial sewer main crossing Cane Creek; and make necessary repairs to the problematic area of Willow and Lee Streets. The proposed project(s) are located within the City of Martin, Weakley County, Tennessee.

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in floodplains and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational tool. The dissemination of information about floodplains can facilitate and enhance Federal efforts to reduce the risks associated with the occupancy and modification of these special areas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the Federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in floodplains, it must inform those who may be put at greater or continued risk.
