Today, Baker Products consists of: machinery manufacturing, pallet manufacturing, sawmill operations, mechanical logging, a gym, farm (hay and cattle), wedding venue, and guided whitetail deer hunts.

Baker Products, which is the machinery manufacturing portion of the business builds band resaws (single cut and multi cut, sawmills, scragg mills, board edgers, cut off saws, notchers/pallet equipment, board dedusters, planers/moulders, conveyors, log decks, specialty equipment, lumber stacking racks, and self dumping steel hoppers.

The pallet manufacturing portion of the business is known as Baker Enterprises. The company has been providing wood pallets to its customers for more than 30 years. From the very beginning, owner and founder Ed Baker has focused on producing high quality hardwood and softwood pallets at a competitive price.

The Bakers have a huge farm where several members of the family live. This farm has been turned into two business ventures—Baker Bucks See Baker. Page B7
