The notion that we should come to the Lord on bended knee and with a humble heart is familiar to most religions. Pride and arrogance are inappropriate attitudes for approaching the all-powerful creator and ruler of the universe, and all of the world's major religions reflect this. In fact the word "Islam" derives from an Arabic word meaning submission or surrender. The idea that we should surrender or submit to the will of God can be hard to accept. We like our freedom and independence, and no one likes to be "under the thumb" of someone else. But the notion of surrender or submission here does not entail that you give up your own free will, but rather that you freely and of your own accord choose to submit to a higher power. There should be no coercion in religion, but rather each must make his or her own decision about submitting to God. This is not something that one can do once and for all, but rather one must do this almost continuously, as one will find that one's natural tendency is to fall back into our own selfish willfulness.

Submit to God and be at peace with him; in this way prosperity will come to you. Accept instruction from his mouth and lay up his wordsin your heart.
