

Gratitude is a social virtue

"Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Thessalonians 5:16-18

Gratitude has the power to transform our lives. We can go from feeling sad, lonely and self-pitying to happy, connected and blessed to be alive in no time at all. One of the reasons why this is the case is that gratitude is almost always directed towards other people. We should be thankful for what others have done for us or have given to us, or simply that they have been there for us in a time of need. This connection with other people is very powerful and gratitude often immediately connects us with others. Though we tend to think of the individual as the basic unit or atom of the larger society, an isolated and unconnected individual is very atypical. To paraphrase Aristotle, only a god or a monster would live apart from all society. Some gratitude exercises which work well are to think of people you are thankful for but who you havenOt actually thanked, and then send them a short thank you note, e-mail or text message. Another one which works well is to keep a gratitude journal, where you write down what you are thankful for at the end of each day. A related exercise is to think about what went well during the day and why, and to write about that.
