**Hours: Mondays 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.; Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.; Thursdays 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.; and Saturdays 9 a.m. to Noon**

Registered voters who will be unable to go to their polling place on Election Day may vote one of the following methods:

**1. Voting by Personal Appearance**—Beginning July 13, 2018 through July 28, 2018 a voter desiring to vote by personal appearance shall go to the DeKalb County Courthouse, first floor, sign an application to vote and cast their vote on a voting machine. The last day to vote by personal appearance during the early voting period is July 28, 2018.

**CELL PHONES:** Under state law, you may use a mobile electronic or communication device for information purposes to assist you in making

communication device for information purposes to assist you in making election decisions at the polling place. You may not use a mobile electronic or communication device for telephone conversations, recording or taking

or communication device for telephone conversations, recording or taking photographs or videos while inside the polling place.

**T.C.A. 2-7-118:** No voter who is voting without assistance may remain in a voting machine or occupy a voting compartment for more than five (5) minutes.
