



**GENERAL SESSIONS**

Sentences were handed down Tuesday morning by Judge Bill Locke in General Sessions Arraignment Court. In the morning session:

Shane Lee Bluth was directed to serve six months for multiple offense driving on a revoked license.

Justin K. Whittemore was directed to serve 30 days of an 11-month, 29-day sentence and pay \$750 plus costs for possession of meth.

Brandy Nicole Turner was instructed to serve 30 days of an 11-29 sentence and must pay \$75 plus costs and was banned from Walmart for shoplifting and criminal trespass. She was given two more days in jail for failure to appear

in court.

Jamie Shawn Jennings was ordered to serve 30 days for public intoxication.

Christopher R. Cameron was directed to serve two days of a six-month sentence and pay \$50 plus costs for driving on a suspended license. He must serve 10 additional days for failure to appear in court.

Matthew D. Hillis was granted a six-month judicial diversion and must pay \$50 plus costs for resisting stop.

Jacob R. Rochon must pay \$10 plus costs for public intoxication.

Ashley B. Basham was given an 11-29 probationary sentence and must pay \$75 plus costs and was

banned from Dollar General for shoplifting.

Robbie A. Bates must serve 30 days and have probation extended by a year for violation of probation.

Gregory Chase Gibson must serve the balance of his sentence for violation of probation.

Houston Shane Anderson

was ordered to serve five days and have his probation extended by six months for violation of probation.

Daniel Holt must serve 30 days for violation of probation.

Brandon G. Martin must serve the balance of his sentence for violation of probation.

**2016 Taxes:**  
You are advised that after March 30, 2018 additional penalties and costs will be imposed in consequence of suits to be filed for enforcement of the lien for taxes against land and personal property; until this date, taxes may be paid at my office.

The last day to pay your 2016 taxes in the Trustee's office is March 30, 2018. **Payment must be received at the Trustee's office by March 30th. Postmarks not accepted.**

**2017 TAXES:**  
You are advised than after February 28, 2018 additional penalties will be imposed upon the 2017 property taxes. Taxpayers can avoid these extra penalties by paying their 2017 taxes before the February 28th deadline.

**For your convenience, the Trustee's office will be open Saturday, February 24th from 9:00 until 12:00.**

**Tax Relief:** The last day to sign up for tax relief is April 5th.
