Galligan book-signing proceeds go to library

Michael Galligan started painting as a small boy just 8 years old. It's a hobby which

has endured a lifetime and given him a chance to detach from the often-stressful job of practicing law.

"Painting gets you to concentrate intensely on something, which is good. It's something different than practicing law," said Galligan.

A strong sampling of Galligan's work is available in a 56-page book called "Mountains and Rivers of Warren County." The book features paintings of some notable places in Warren County, including The Birthing Tree, Barren Fork River, Collins River, and Long Mountain.

"We have so much beauty in Warren County and this book shows some of it," said Galligan.

Galligan received his first painting lessons from David Burluik, a noted book illustrator and neo-primitive artist. These lessons took place at the home of his aunt, Dorothy Wells, in Bradenton, Fla.

"I painted when I was young and I painted some in college, but I put it away for a while when I went off with the Marines," said Galligan. "I really didn't pick it up again until my son Trevor went off to college in 1999."

A vigorous supporter of Magness Library, Galligan held a book signing party Saturday night at the library. He sold 97 copies of his book for \$30 apiece, then donated all of that money, \$2,910, back to the library.
