By the time Esparza doubled and Danika Reno ripped a single into left field to put two more runners aboard, coach Joe Damon made the decision to stop the scoring. Esparza and Reno both stepped off base before pitches and were called out to end the inning.

The Lady Pioneers would do the same in the second. After Madison Hollis sat down Franklin South on 13 pitches in the second inning, including two looking third strikes, Warren County went back to work offensively.

Eight straight runners reached base to the start the second. Halo

Armstrong singled and scored, but coach Damon decided to have two runners again step off base with no outs and the bases loaded when it looked like a walk would score another run.

Walks loaded the bases once again with two outs and Damon subbed out his whole lineup when the top of the order came back to the plate. Subs Dallis Melton and Bella Bain responded with RBI singles, making it 14-0 before another runner stepping off the base ended the inning.

Bain entered and pitched the final two innings, giving up two runs on two hits while walking two and striking

out two. The game ended after four innings by run rule. Hollis earned the win after striking out four while pitching to only six batters in two innings.

Esparza led the team with two hits, while Pyburn had a team-high two RBIs.

Warren County concluded its series with Franklin South with a road game Tuesday. The score was unavailable at press time.

The Lady Pioneers will be back on their home turf Thursday for a 5 p.m. game against the DeKalb County Lady Saints, who are coached by former WCHS softball standout Sarah Jacobs.
