"The truck is in Nashville. VFIS is who the actual truck insurance is from. The liability side of it is through Southern Insurance so it's a partnership. They had to notify

VFIS because of it potentially being a total loss. As soon as they get the OK, they are going to send an adjuster there. They are going to go in and tell us what they think. Once the adjuster looks at it, it will be released to us." Denney expressed concern for the equipment and medication in the ambulance during that timeframe.

"There's a large amount of equipment on it," said Denney. "They said we could do whatever we needed to do to retrieve the equipment. We'd have to take an empty ambulance, because we'll fill it up with all the equipment. Once the adjuster is done, we could tow it back here. We typically use Hullett's because he has a big enough wrecker." Denney said he's been tentatively looking for a replacement truck.
