a.i. Most record searches are done by title companies, banks, surveyors, genealogists and other professional businesses. By providing a subscription service this helps protect the citizens of


Warren County from identity theft and property fraud.

The Register's staff is not in the IT business to handle IT calls. Hardware maintenance, Credit Card billing, Mailing of invoices and all other aspects of hosting web services.

a.iii. Higher speed data line costs for large document downloads.

a.iv. Even Rutherford County (Murfreesboro) went away from hosting their own website due to the amount of manpower, cost and IT expertise required.
