Drive 4UR School Saturday

Test driving a Ford this Saturday, April 21, could be a big play for Warren County High School's football team.

As part of a Ford-sponsored program called Drive 4UR School, each test drive will earn a \$20 donation to the football team. And, as an added incentive, the donation can reach \$8,000, which is more than the usual \$6,000 limit.

"We'll have our new EcoSport to test drive. If we get people to take a spin in our brand new SUV models, they can earn even more for the football team," said Kidd Ford owner Terry Kidd, who noted the EcoSport has similar fuel economy of a sedan, but gives the feel and space of an SUV.

Kidd Ford on Manchester Highway has held the promotion over 20 times in the past for local programs. Kidd estimates the earnings from the fundraisers have exceeded \$100,000 for community programs.

The event will be held at the dealership this Saturday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. It's a program the Kidd Ford owner is pleased to offer.

"I'm a big supporter of high school athletics and \$8,000 will be a big help to the football team," said Kidd. "We want everybody to come take a test drive, fill out the forms and help the team. We may have a few special deals available too. It will be nice to get people acquainted with the new Fords, and it will be nice to help the football team too."

The Drive One 4UR School promotion is an easy way to make a monetary donation to the football program without paying any money. All it takes is a quick test drive, Kidd says.

Since launching in December 2007, thousands of events have taken place nationwide, raising more than \$35 million in support of schools and community events.
