TVA Invites Public Comment on Updates at Shawnee Fossil Plant

The Tennessee Valley Authority is considering the environmental impacts of closing some of its coal combustion residuals (CCR) storage sites at Shawnee Fossil Plant, and constructing a new area for processing plant operations water at the site.

A draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) detailing the plans is available at www.tva.gov/nepa. The public is invited to review and comment on the plan. Other related documents are also available on the website.

This supplemental plan is related to an Environmental Impact Statement announced in January 2018 as part of TVA's overall commitment to move from wet to dry storage of coal ash and other CCR at all our coal-fired plants. At the time, TVA chose to further consider the alternatives for closure of its wet ash impoundment and the former special waste landfill at Shawnee before making a decision on those items.

The draft SEIS considers the environmental impacts of another closure alternative and the construction of basins that will collect and treat process water from the plant. This project would include the closure in place of the former special waste landfill and ash impoundment, and regrading those areas. This new proposed alternative would require less movement of CCR material and would result in greater stability of the site.

This SEIS does not impact the decision to build a new dry storage landfill on a portion of TVA property near the eastern boundary of the site. This landfill will provide additional long-term disposal of dry CCR produced at Shawnee.
