## Warriors rout Cavaliers for third title in four years

CLEVELAND (AP)

Golden State. Golden still. Stephen Curry scored 37 points, NBA Finals MVP Kevin Durant added 20 and a triple-double and the Warriors stamped themselves a dynasty after winning their second straight title and third in four years Friday night, 108-85 over the Cleveland Cavaliers to complete a sweep and perhaps drive LeBron James from his home again to chase champion-

Overcoming obstacles all season long, the Warriors were not going to be denied and won the fourth straight finals matchup against Cleveland with ease.

"This is so hard to do and doing it three out of four years is incredible," guard Klay Thompson said.

It was the first sweep in

the NBA Finals since 2007, when James was dismissed by a powerful San Antonio team in his first one. His eighth straight appearance

didn't go well either, and there's uncertainty now where the superstar will play next.

James finished with 23

points and spent the final minutes on the bench, contemplating what went wrong and maybe his next


"Balancing is definitely a challenge, but there's nothing like waiting until the last minute to write a paper," said Cripps.
