Construction and renovaat Bobby tion Rav Elementary will now include a new roof for Building B.

The county Financial Management Committee met and approved the lowest bid received.

"We had two bids," said Director of Schools Bobby Cox. "Porter Roofing was the low bid. We varied that and we recommend the low bid from Porter Roofing."

The company's base bid was \$169,713. Two alternates of \$24,510 and \$11,226 brought the total replacement cost up to \$205,449. County Executive Herschel Wells asked, "Is that a rubber roof?"

"Yes," said Cox.

unanimously. Work is scheduled to begin in July.

Members also considered a bid to replace three cafeteria serving lines at Warren County High School for its Warren County Schools Nutrition Department.

"We are trying to replace some of those that need to be replaced at the high school," said Cox. "We are going to repurpose some of the ones we can use in the other schools."

Partial description of the serving lines: exterior body 18-gauge stainless panels and 14-gauge galvanized bottom, and exterior top constructed of 14-gauge stainless steel, welded, ground and polished into one integral unit.

Committee members unanimously approved the low bid from Mobile Fixture which totaled \$77,838.
