# EARLY VOTING SAMPLE BALLOT

## EARLY VOTING DATES AND HOURS

ANY REGISTERED VOTER IN WARREN COUNTY CAN VOTE EARLY. NO REASON IS REQUIRED. EACH EARLY VOTER IS REQUIRED TO PRESENT A PHOTO ID. ACCEPTABLE FORMS ARE TENNESSEE DRIVER'S LICENSE OR HANDGUN PERMIT WITH PHOTO, U. S. PASSPORT, TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY ID, PHOTO ID ISSUED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR THE STATE OF TENNESSEE SUCH AS AN EMPLOYEE ID FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY OR U.S. MILITARY PHOTO ID, INCLUDING A VETERAN'S IDENTIFICATION CARD.

COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION ONLY

**IMPORTANT NOTE!** Any voter voting in a primary **MUST** choose their party preference. However, the voter may select ANY candidate in the County General Election regardless of party affiliation.

Governor, US Senate, US Representative—4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District,

### ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL (NO PHOTO ID REQUIRED)

Under certain circumstances you may request that a ballot application be mailed to you. Any Warren County voter who is over 60 years of age, expects to be out of the county all hours of early voting and election day, is hospitalized or disabled, the caretaker of a hospitalized or disabled voter, enrolled as a full time student outside the county, or in possession of a Commercial Driver's License and will be unable to appear in person to vote (must include a copy of the CDL), may mail, fax or email (requires an attached document with voter's signature) a request which contains ALL information listed below will be treated as an application and a ballot will be mailed. The required information is:

- Name of voter
- Residence address
- Social security number
- Date of birth
- Reason for requesting a ballot by mail
- Which party primary ballot you are requesting if any, Republican or Democratic
- Address to mail the ballot if different than residence address
- SIGNATURE OF VOTER

Applications for by-mail ballots must be received by the Election Office no later than July 26th. Emails must be sent to warren.commission@tn.gov

### VOTING BY HOSPITALIZED VOTERS (NO PHOTO ID REQUIRED)

A voter hospitalized between July 13 and Election Day may request the services of an Emergency Registrar who will supply a ballot to them in the hospital. This emergency service may be requested by the voter calling the Election Office at (931) 473-5834 no later than 8 a.m. when the polls open on Election Day, August 2, 2018.
