That left Tyler Marz, promoted from the practice squad the day before, to start and play in his first NFL game. While not included in the program, the Titans website lists Marz as an undrafted third-year player out of Wisconsin.
As for the 66-yard TD, the Titans longest play this season, that connection had safety Kevin Byard throwing to safety Dane Cruikshank on a fake punt.
"It's not something we just checked into at the line of scrimmage," said Vrabel during his post-game press conference.

Vrabel said the Texans have a tendency to leave the gunner uncovered and they had been practicing for just such a situation all week.
"Let me tell you, he was looking awful throwing that ball in practice," said cornerback Logan Ryan in walking over to joke with Byard at his locker after the game.
Added cornerback Adoree Jackson, "That will get his passer rating up."
The Titans would rather rely on Marcus Mariota throwing the ball this Sunday against a punishing Jacksonville defense. Mariota was another offensive starter sidelined

Sunday after suffering an elbow injury in Week 1.
The last time the two teams met was in Week 17 of the 2017 regular season when the Titans captured a 15-10 win on a frigid night in Nashville to secure a playoff berth. Mariota threw for 134 yards with nearly half those yards coming on one play, a 66-yard TD to RB Derrick Henry on a screen pass.
Sunny Florida figures to provide a much different environment this Sunday and Titans No. 1 WR Corey Davis will need to improve on his zero-catch performance the last time the two teams met.
Jags QB Blake Bortles,

known for his unique ability to self-destruct, is coming off a 4-TD, 377-yard game against New England. Bruising RB Leonard Fournette missed that game due to a ham-

string injury, giving Jag fans a reason to monitor the injury report.
Jacksonville ranks better statistically with the No. 7 defense and the No. 9 offense.

The Titans are ranked 25th in both offense and defense.
The Titans have won two of the last three. Kickoff is scheduled Sunday at noon.
