WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

Sheriff Jackie Matheny heads this law enforcement body.

A former McMinnville policeman, Matheny was elected to his first term in 1994 and has been re-elected six times since first taking office. He will finish his sixth term on Aug. 31, 2018 and is not seeking re-election. He will leave with 24 years of service and as the longest serving sheriff in Warren County history.

Matheny's present staff includes chief deputy Tommy Myers and chief investigator Marc Martin.

The sheriff's department has 100 employees, including 24 road deputies, six investigators, five court officers, four dispatchers, five full-time administration employees, 35 jailers, two road crew guards, two transport officers, three nurses, one dietician, one receptionist, and 11 school resource officers.

The duties of the road deputies include patrolling the county's 431 square miles and answering calls for assistance from the public.

Deputies also serve all criminal, civil, subpoenas and state papers.

The investigation section of the department, which investigates the county's crimes, is headed by Martin, who oversees the work of investigators Capt. Bo Ramsey, Jason Rowland, Jody Cavanaugh, Steven Carpenter, Aaron Roberts and Travis Thaxton.

Warren County Jail is located along with the sheriff's office on Security Circle off Sparta Street near the Three Star Mall. It has a capacity of 251 inmates.

The jail routinely operates over capacity with more than 300 inmates. The county has currently committed to borrowing \$6 million for a jail expansion to increase capacity to around 400 inmates. County officials hope to begin construction for the jail addition in 2018.

The sheriff's department operates under the supervision of the county Corrections Partnership Committee.

MCMINNVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

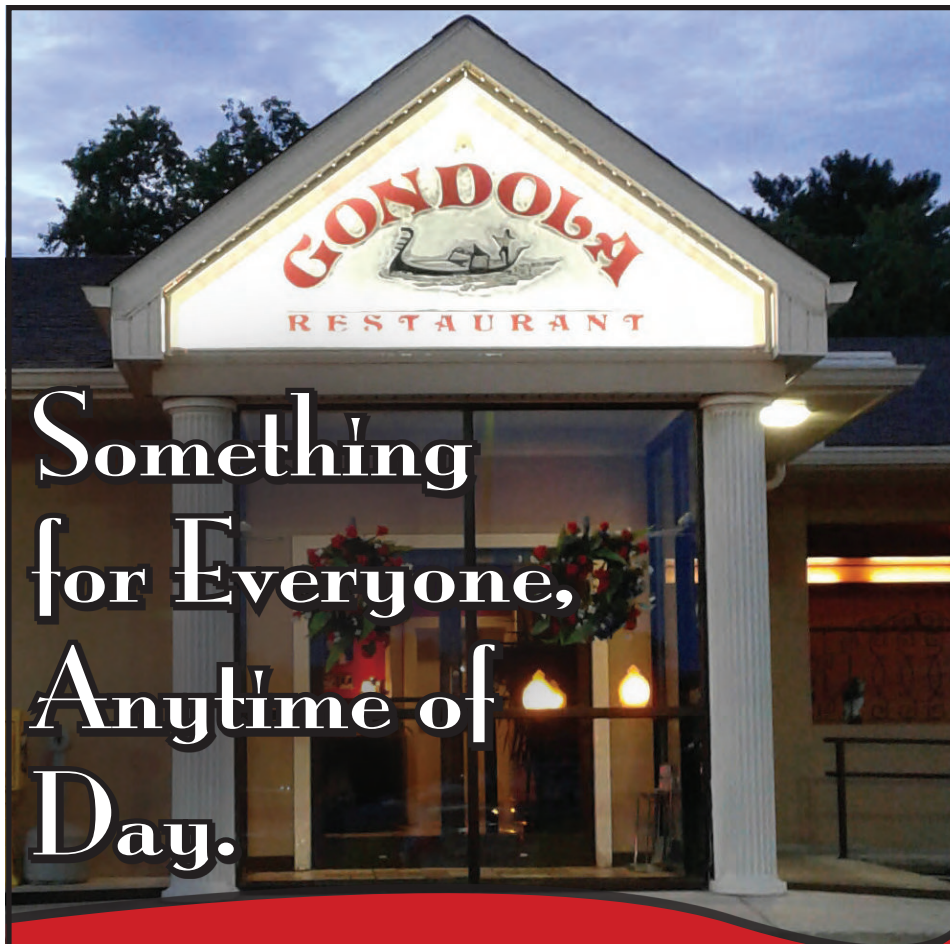
McMinnville Police Department is headed by Police Chief Bryan Denton.

The police department operates on an average budget of over \$3.5 million. The department's assistant police chief is Major Mike Lane.

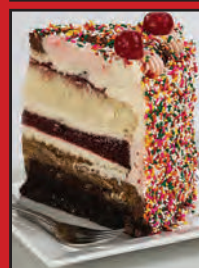
MPD has 34 officers, four office staff, and also has eight volunteers in the Public Safety Unit. The department is charged with patrolling the city's more than 10 square miles.

The city's investigatory unit is headed by Capt. Derwin Adcock. He supervises the work of investigators Sgt. Nichole Mosley, Stuart Whitman, Todd Rowland, Marty Cantrell and Tony Jenkins. Shift lieutenants include Lt. Bo Hutchins, Lt. Mark Mara, Lt. Lisa Norris, and Lt. Paul Springer.
