

Jennie Trent Dew Library Invites Visitors to Read, Relax & Connect

Books, magazines, movies, etc. — as well as computer access — are available free to the public right in downtown Goldthwaite.

Patrons can check out more than books at the Jennie Trent Dew Public Library. The library has Large Print books, Audio Books both on cassette tape and CD, music CDs and VHS and DVD videos.

Magazines and paperbacks are also available. The library also belongs to a digital consortium with many fiction and non-fiction titles available for download to a mobile device. The link to this consortium is located on our home page JT-Dlibrary.net.

The library offers 14 workstations with Internet access for public use. You may set up a free Internet e-mail account online. Signing up for the computers is on a first come, first served basis, and patrons may use a work station for one hour.

Children may also use the workstations with Internet access if a parent or guardian has signed an Internet safety contract for the child.

There is no charge for the use of the computer with the exception of printing, for which we charge 10 cents per page for black and white and 25 cents for color.

Other software available for use on the computers includes Microsoft Office; Access (a database authoring program); Excel (a spreadsheet program); Publisher (a program for creating flyers, brochures, catalogs, and Web sites); and Word (a word-processing program).

One of the workstations is equipped with a scanner and Adobe Creative Suite 6 software, which includes Photoshop, Illustrator, and Dreamweaver.

All persons using the workstations must sign an Internet safety contract. All persons under the age of 17 must have a parent or guardian come into the library to sign an Internet safety contract for them.

the side of the building next to the parking lot that separates the library from the Family Dollar.

The library is open Sunday from 1 to 5 p.m.; Monday to Thursday from 10:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.; and Friday 10:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. The library is closed on Saturdays.
