"It's a tight community of people who go to car shows a lot," Berryhill said. "If you go to a car show in another town, people will pass out fliers for their car show while they walk around and check out each other's cars. That, and word of mouth, is how we advertise. Last year we probably went to around eight."

Berryhill said she believes being a part of a larger event like the Ice Cream Festival helps the car show.

"The Ice Cream Festival has been around so long, people look forward to it every year," she said. "It draws a lot of vendors, a lot of visitors to our town. Since they're already here walking around, they see there's a car show."

All cars are welcome and the classes so far are 1928-1954 Coupe or Sedan, 1955-1957 Classic Chevy, 1955-1957 Ford, 1958-1964 Late Great Chevy, 1955-1975 Convertible, 1958-Present: Original, 1958-Present: Modified, 1964 ½ -Present Mustang, Camaro/Firebird, 1906-1972 Truck, 1973-Present Truck, Muscle Car: Original, Muscle Car: Modified, Rat Rod, Unfinished: 75% or less, Roadster/Race Car, Motorcycle, Corvette, Import, Mopar-Classic, and Mopar-Modern.

Registration is \$20 and all the money generated will go back into the community via programs such as Shop with a Cop and other charitable efforts.
