Thrill rides include the seven-story looping Brain Drain, high-speed steel Silver Bullet, the classic Wildcat wooden coaster and several others.

Together families can enjoy a gondola Ferris Wheel, a train trip around the park and a variety of multi-rider rides for people of all ages.

Children can enjoy the Flying Dragons, Indian Canoes, a petting zoo and even a Wild Kitty mini-coaster at the park's many kiddie rides.

The park is also home to several water rides to help guests cool off from the summer heat, including the Mystery River Log Flume, Renegade Rapids and a Wild West Water Works water activity structure.
