As for where he will play next, Cordale Flott had a long list of suitors, being offered by most of the schools in the SEC and origi nally committing to Auburn. But in recent months he de-committed from Auburn and has cast his commitment to LSU, where he is expected to play next season.



But for now, he's a Saraland Spartan, and they are happy to have him.

'On the field, I think Cordale is the best corner that I've ever coached," Kelly said. "He's tremendous in press coverage and he has good length — I know that's what gets a lot of people turned on to him, he can get his hands on you pretty quick. He can flat out run and Cordale is athletic enough that I think he can hurt you on both sides of the ball, so I wouldn't be surprised if he doesn't factor in at some point in time offensively as well."
