Petty is a Gordonsville graduate who, like Clemons, served as a longtime assistant coach for the Tigers. Petty returns after a seven season hiatus from high school football.

Shaw comes to Gordonsville from the Macon County High coaching staff.

Gary Glover – "He was an All-State player when he played here. He is a high motor guy who coaches the game like he played. He will coach our defensive line and help with the tight ends.






