“Grundy Co. has a new head coach in Scott Smith who we faced a few years ago. Coach Smith loves to have multiple sets and formations to confuse your defense. We must have a good week of preparation as, once again, this region game can determine whether we make the playoffs or not.”

OFFENSIVE LINE:
CHRIS RAY (5’11”, 270, Sr.), **GREG BASS** (5’11”, 315, Sr.), **JARED GRISHAM** (6’0”, 200, Jr.), **AUSTIN WILLIAMS** (5’11”, 200, Sr.), **RAY SCURLOCK** (6’0”, 185, So.), **JORDAN TONGATE** (6’2”, 200, Sr.).

“This group must have a good year for us if we are going to enjoy any type of success. We must be able to run the football and we are hoping to get four yards a carry and keep the chains moving. We will be a ball control offense and hopefully keep the ball away from our opponents.”

Backups: **CHRIS CUNNINGHAM** (5’10”, 275, Jr.), **RANDALL RAY** (5’11”, 255, So.), **JOEY GANTENBEIN** (6’0”, 185, Jr.), **CAMERON BRIDGES** (5’10”, 200, So.), **TYLER BARE** (5’9”, 185, So.), **TRISTAN MCCORMICK** (6’1”, 200, Jr.).

“These guys must be ready to play as they are only one snap away from being a starter. They must be reliable backups in case someone goes down.”

WIDE RECEIVERS:
ELI MARTIN (5’10”, 180, Jr.), **JADEN APPLE-GIBBS** (5’10”, 165, Jr.).

“These two guys had some catches for us a year ago and must step up this year to be leaders when we throw the football. We expect them to be able to make yards after the catch for us to have a successful passing game.”

Backups: **ISAAC DICK** (6’3”, 170, Sr.), **CHRIS ALLEN** (5’9”, 135, Sr.).

“These guys will be rotating in and out and must catch the football when it is thrown their way.”

TAILBACKS:

JOHN ROSS HORD (5’11”, 185, Jr.).

“John Ross is our leading returning ball carrier from a year ago and he has to have a big year for us if we are going to be successful on offense. He is a rugged runner that needs to be able to carry the football 20-25 times a game. We believe he has the ability to carry us in the rushing department.”

Backup: **ROGELIO ORTIZ** (5’9”, 145, Fr.).

FULLBACKS:
TANNER MARSHALL (5’10”, 175, Sr.).

“Tanner must have a good year blocking and running for us to do the things that we want to do on offense. We hope to be able to run a ball control offense and must be able to run the football.”

Backup: **BRAXTON WASHER** (5’10”, 190, Jr.).

QUARTERBACKS:
CAMERON SPIVEY (5’9”, 165, Jr.).

“I feel Cameron can handle our offense and although he doesn’t have a lot of experience, we are asking him to make good decisions and not risk turning the ball over. He has been a good leader for us throughout fall camp and we are looking for him to have a steady year for us.”

Backup: **JADEN APPLE-GIBBS** (5’10”, 165, Jr.), **ANDREW WHEELLEY** (5’9”, 120, Fr.).

“We think we with Jaden’s athletic ability that he could be a reliable backup for us if we need him to be.”
