The trips provide our young people with often life-changing experiences as they complete meaningful projects such as roofing, siding, painting, building wheelchair ramps, and landscaping."

"Additionally," Wasmund continues, "Our groups, which average around 45 young people, also have the opportunity to lead children's outreach programs and reach out to individuals and communities through Christian service."
