INFORMATION

Date/Time: The competition will take place on Thursday, August 9th, 2018 at the Hancock County Fairgrounds. Registration must be completed from 5:00pm. - 6:00pm. the competition will begin after.

AGE: Participants 4-9 years, 10-15 years, 16 and up.

LIABILITY: All participants are required to sign a liability waiver on the day of the competition. Once the liability waiver has been signed, participants will receive a sticker. Participants must have a sticker on helmet to enter the competition.

Restrictions: Contestants must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs before or during the competition. Contestants in violation of this policy will be immediately disqualified from the competition and will not be allowed to compete.

Competition Rules:

All participants agree to compete in a fair manner and follow all the rules. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. The event will be timed by one stop watch and all times are final. No Refunds!

Superintendents: A panel of fairboard members will review all scenarios not covered by the

listed rules. All decisions made by the Fairboard members are final.

Anyone competing and/or operating an ATV are required to wear a D.O.T. helmet (helmet must be worn at all times while operating an ATV), eye protection (glasses, goggles, face shield), long sleeved shirt, long pants and closed-toe shoes. Other protective gear is strongly recommended.

Golfcarts: You will not be required to wear long sleeved shirt or long pants.

Stock and modified machines are allowed. Any size tire is allowed. Paddles, chains and spikes are NOT allowed. Natural aspiration only. No nitrous oxide and no nitro methane may be used. Insurance and registration is highly recommended.

ATV's may be inspected at any time and at the discretion of the Superintendents.

Participants may enter more than one class, but may enter each class only once. All machines may be used by more than 1 competitor.

The number of participants per class may be limited by the fairboard members.

Operators must stay on their machine during the run; dismounting from the machine terminates the run, unless otherwise instructed in the event description then the machine has to be shut off.

Event machines cannot be ridden outside of the Arena and pits. Speed limit in the pits is 5mph.

In case of a breakdown, riders are responsible for hooking the tow rope to his/her machine; any and all damages incurred when being towed are the sole responsibility of the rider.

We reserve the right to rework the course at any time.

The Hancock County Fair Coordinators, Members and its representatives are not responsible for accidents, injury or theft to property. Personal ATV/UTV, Motorcycle, golfcart insurance and registration is highly recommended.

Noncompliance with the rules of this event may result in disqualification, expulsion and forfeiture of all prizes.

Prizes: 70% of money of each class will be awarded based on the combined times of all designated events(one winner each class). Riders must compete in all designated events to qualify.

Classes: 70% Payback Each Class, \$5 Per Event

Golfcart - Motorcycle - Utility - Sport

Events: All or some of the events listed below may be run and/or counted for money.

Barrel Race - Panty Race - Horseshoe - Flag Race

Tire Race-ATV Only, You have to be 16 and over to participate

Barrel Race - The fastest time running the designated pattern around the barrels. The pattern may be run either direction. Each barrel knocked over will result in a 5 second penalty. Breaking the pattern will result in disqualification.

Panty Race - The fastest time running the designated pattern and getting the correct colored panties on and back across finish line. When (getting off the vehicle) and searching for panties the vehicle has to be shut off.

Horseshoe - The fastest time running the horseshoe around the arena. The pattern must be run, right handed. Golfcarts have to do it backwards then forwards.

Flag Race - The fastest time running the designated pattern. the pattern may be run in either direction. Each barrel or flag knocked over will result in a 5 second penalty. Breaking the pattern will result in disqualification. Golfcarts have to run it forward and backwards.
