EVENT RULES—MUDPIT:

You must wear helmet on all machines and seat belts in UTV's. To compete in our event your safety is our #1 concern. **YOU HOOK TO YOUR OWN MACHINE.** WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO YOUR MACHINE. You have to have one foot and one hand on ATV at all times, or you will not be able to push the machine. At no time during your run are you allowed to touch the ground unless you are flipping over, at which that point you must be off the throttle. You must stay in the pit, and no wall climbing or you will be stopped and measured where you started climbing the wall. You will be brought to the starting line when the flag drops, the timer starts. When you are told to stop, STOP, this means your forward progress has stopped and we will measure your distance. Also the timer will stop when your forward progress stops according to flagger. \$10 per pass, no more than 2 passes per machine (which means you can change tires bigger or smaller once, which puts you in a separate class). Classes are separated into 3-wir, atv, utv classes, each class will have a up to 29.5" and a 30" and up class. 2X4 and 4X4 also. Running order will be determined by class and a number given at sign up. Running 3-wir small tire, then large, then atv, then utv. Each class will have 1 winner and they shall receive 7-% of their class purse. Each machine will be inspected and checked to be sure you are in your right class. No arguing!!! We are new at this and are doing this for YOU.

That is why it is 70% payback. Any disagreements and you will be asked to leave without refund. We are doing are best.
